<p>Transfer of data to a third country or an international organization and the associated safeguards to protect the data</p>	<p>It is not intended to transmit the data to third countries unless it is necessary for the processing of your request.</p> <p>If you submit your request from a third country, your request will be forwarded to the local Phoenix Contact company. A transfer to this country will then be necessary to process your request.</p> <p>To protect the data within the Phoenix Contact group companies, there is an international Phoenix Contact data protection framework agreement based on the EU standard contractual clauses joined by all relevant Phoenix Contact companies worldwide.</p>
<p>Storage duration of the data</p>	<p>Depending on the content of your request, different retention periods may apply to your data. These can be up to 10 years in individual cases, provided that your request is relevant under commercial or tax law.</p> <p>The form data that you entered on the website will be deleted automatically after 12 months (calculated from the end of the current calendar year).</p>
